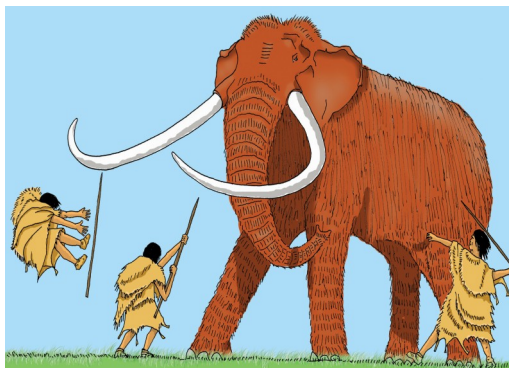


SURVIVING THE STONE AGE
